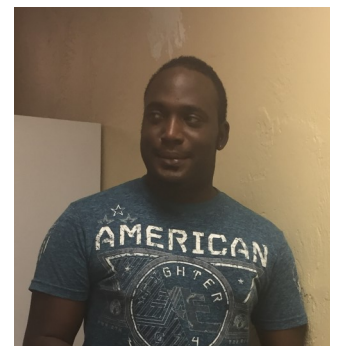
Diane Childs
