As a defining characteristic of a clubhouse Transitional Employment program, the Clubhouse guarantees coverage on all placements during member absences.

*Members have a **Right** to a safe place to come.*

Members will be treated with dignity and respect at the GOC.

*Members have a **Responsibility** to treat others how they wish to be treated.*

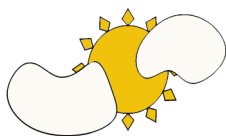

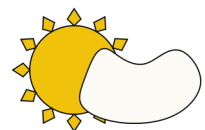
