CIT Training at GOC : Every quarter we host a roundtable for Crisis Intervention Training (CIT.) Last Monday we had another training. Officers from Gainesville Police, Alachua County Sheriff's Office, UF, Santa Fe, and other state law enforcement officers come to these meetings to hear from our Members. Since they often see people with mental illness when they are in crisis, it is important that they meet with us when we are as we usually are (just like everybody else!!!!!) We had a wide range of officers represented this time, including jail deputies and state law enforcement from the Department of Agriculture.

Standard #10

Clubhouse staff have generalist roles. All staff share employment, housing, evening and weekend, holiday and unit responsibilities. Clubhouse staff do not divide their time between Clubhouse and other major work responsibilities that conflict with the unique nature of member/ staff relationships.

Members have a **Right** to a safe place to come. Members will be treated with dignity and respect at the GOC. Members have a **Responsibility** to treat others how they wish to be treated.
