Standard #22

The Clubhouse offers its own Transitional Employment program, which provides as a right of membership opportunities for members to work on job placement in the labor market. As a defining characteristic of a Clubhouse Transitional Employment program, the Clubhouse guarantees coverage on all placements during member absences. In addition the Transitional Employment program meets the following basic criteria.

*Members have a **Right** to a safe place to come.*

Members will be treated with dignity and respect at the GOC.

*Members have a **Responsibility** to treat others how they wish to be treated.*
